## 1. Plan your trip to the NAPE Conference, February 5-9

- FREE METRO Greenlink shuttles arrive at the GRB every 7-10 minutes
- METRORail trains arrive at Convention District Station every 8 minutes

## 2. Pay your fare



Q Mobile Ticketing app – Download, pay and store one or more tickets using your smartphone



Cash – Pay at the fare box on your bus (exact change only) or at any Ticket Vending Machine (TVM) – located on all rail platforms



METRO Q<sup>®</sup> Fare Card – Use it like a reloadable debit card. Get yours now online, through our RideStore or at select retailers. The roundtrip cost to ride our local bus and rail service is just \$2.50. **Buy now >>>**



METRO Day Pass – Buy one for only \$3.00 per day and ride unlimited METRO local bus and METRORail service. **Buy now >>>**

## 3. Get on board and ride to the conference

*METRO Park & Ride service is also available, with most lots offering FREE parking. Fares vary depending on location and transfers are FREE to complete your travel to the George R. Brown Convention Center.*
